

## **Road Captain Qualifications and Responsibilities:**

### ***National HOG Required:***

- Assists the sponsoring dealer and chapter officers in upholding the “Annual Charter for H.O.G. Chapters”
- Assists in planning routes for chapter rides
- Educates chapter members about the towing reimbursement program
- Assists in keeping the chapter informed of H.O.G. programs
- Educates chapter members about group riding techniques
- Informs chapter members of any hand signals used by the chapter on group rides
- Assists in obtaining signed release forms for chapter rides
- Acts as a guide for organized chapter rides
- Cannot drink alcohol or consume drugs while on duty, start to finish of that day’s ride.

### ***Fox Valley HOG Recommendations:***

1. Must have been riding 5 years and have ridden a minimum of 20,000 miles
2. Must have led and/or organized two group rides of more than 10 bikes successfully
3. Must have following mechanical abilities:
  - Know how to contact National Hog road assistance and have that number in their cell phone.
4. Must be able to carry first-aid kit and provide road side assistance while on duty
5. Must have cell phone while on duty
6. Recommend attending First-responder type course
7. Recommend attending ERC
8. Must forego aggressive personal riding style while on duty and ride to ability of the least experienced rider of the group, obey traffic laws and speed limits.
9. Must attend two Road Captain meetings per year.

10. Must give criticism diplomatically when needed in private (for safety of group) and coach.
